Faïez Gargouri is a computer science Professor at the Higher Institute of computer science and multimedia at the University of Sfax, Tunisia (www.isimsf.rnu.tn), where he was the Head (from 2014 to 2020 and from 2007 to 2011). He was also the Director of the Multimedia, InfoRmation Systems and Advanced Computing Laboratory (www.miracl.rnu.tn) (from 2016 to 2020 and from 2011 to 2014). He is the Vice President of the University of Sfax, Tunisia (www.univ-sfax.tn) in charge of training offers, pedagogy and employability, since 15/12/2020, and the President of its quality committee and the coordinator of its PAQ-DGSU project. Faiez GARGOURI is also the University of Sfax's representative into the Scientific Council of the Tunisia Virtual University and into the International Advisor Board of the MECAM (https://mecam.tn/): a research center for interdisciplinary research and academic exchange. He is also a scientific consultant representing Tunisia to the European Union in the field of information and communication technologies since September 2020. He is also involved in many international projects (Tempus, Erasmus, Prima, Twining, CMCU, ...).

Faïez Gargouri obtained his Master's degree in Computer Science from the Paris 6 University (1990) and a PhD from the Paris 5 University (1995). In 2002, he obtained an Habilitation Universitaire en Informatique from the University of Tunis (Tunisia).

His research interest focuses on different information systems' fields, such as, Design, Quality Measurement, Verification, Data Warehousing, Multimedia, Knowledge Management and Ontology. He published more than 350 papers in journals and conferences and more than ten books (pedagogical or conference proceedings). He is member of the Scientific and Steering committees of major international conferences and jornals. He is namely one of the founding fathers of the JFO conference (French Workshops on Ontologies) and ASD (Conference on decisional systems).

Faiez Gargouri is the founder of the scientific association AIG (Association Informatique de Gestion), President of the APPAD (Association du Patrimoine et des Proprietaires des Anciennes Demeures) association and he is a Chevalier de l'ordre national du mérite in the Education and Science fields (Décret numéro 2009 – 2195 du 16 juillet 2009).
